How to Use This Guide

- Every day in October, choose at least one prayer focus — or pray through them all.
 - Prayers will repeat so we stay united as a body, calling out for God to move.
 - Each week comes with a theme and worship songs we've chosen to help you focus— whether that's while you pray or as you prepare your heart beforehand. Start by reading the Scripture, then move into the prayer prompts. Remember, these prompts are simply a guide to get you started. Ask God to use them to lead you into the prayers He desires for you.

Week 1: God, Start with Me (Oct 1–7)

Theme Verse: Psalm 63:1 – “O God, you are my God; earnestly I seek you...”

Songs to Listen to: “Lord, I Need You” by The Worship Initiative, “The Wick (Set a Fire)” by MBL Worship, “More” by Red Rocks Worship, “Make Room” by The Church Will Sing

Oct 1–7 (repeat daily):

- God, open my eyes to see You as You truly are.
 - Allow the revival I'm praying for our church and city to start in me.
 - Stir in me a deep hunger for Your presence.
 - Give me the desire and wisdom to be somebody who is radically pursuing you in every area of my life.
 - Teach me to pray — make prayer my DNA.
 - Lead me to either find a community to belong to, or deepen the community I already have.
 - Forgive my apathy; make me burn with passion for You.
 - Change my heart to align with Yours. Let what breaks Your heart break mine.
 - Revive repentance in me.
 - Teach me to fall deeply and madly in love with Jesus.
 - Let my prayer life overflow into my home, church, and workplace.
 - Set a fire in me I cannot contain or control.
 - Give me impossible prayers — and faith to believe You'll answer.
 - Lord, what else could I be praying for that this list is missing?

Week 2: God, Shape Our Church (Oct 8–14)

Theme Verse: Acts 2:42 – “They devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.”

Songs to Listen to: “For the One” by Bethel Music, “Firm Foundation” by Maverick City, “Be Thou My Vision” by Ascend the Hill, “Clear the Stage” by Jimmy Needham

Oct 8–14 (repeat daily):

- Raise up thousands of leaders in our church — a feeding ground for staff and other churches.
 - Bring gifted leaders for the next generation, student ministry, worship, and future ministries.
 - Give us worship leaders and musicians with holy vision who lead us into Your throne room.
 - Pour out revival in our children, students, and college ministry.
 - Give wisdom in the hiring process (executive pastor, worship and community pastor, student, future positions). Let every hire be a culture add.
 - Give people the stirring to serve so that it will lead to an abundance of people partnering with the Holy Spirit. Such an abundance that it will create more and exciting opportunities for future ministry impact.
 - We are a growing church. Lord, give our leaders wisdom in how to love people well and set up structures to support the growth we're experiencing. If it's going to 2 services, would you give us wisdom in how to do it well and make it to where we're 2 services, 1 body?
 - Fill our church with authenticity, love, and joy in Christ that leads to revival in our church.
 - Provide supernatural financial blessing to pay off the building — and fuel more Kingdom work.
 - Let prayer become the engine room of our church.
 - Give us unity — one heart, one mission, one Spirit.
 - May every sermon and teaching be filled with Your power and wisdom.
 - Lord, what else can I pray for our church that isn't on this list?

Week 3: God, Move Through Us To Be A Blessing In Our City (Oct 15–21)

Theme Verse: Romans 1:16 – “For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.”

Songs to Listen to: “God of This City” by Chris Tomlin, “Available” by Elevation Worship, “Gratitude” by Passion, “I’ll Witness It” by Passion

Oct 15–21 (repeat daily):

- Make our church an embassy of Heaven — filled with Your Presence, no darkness allowed that is a beacon of hope in our city.
- Would the churches in our city be unified in a way that we know it's from you?
- Ignite revival in Searcy; let it spread to neighborhoods and workplaces.
- Launch new ministries (coffee shop, residency, Fellowship Music) to disciple people daily.
- Give us wisdom to begin prayer walks in our neighborhoods.
- Let our momentum be Spirit-driven, unstoppable, and undeniable.
- Make this church a place it's impossible to not be radical in love, service, and mission.
- Give us boldness to love the disgruntled, unchurched, and hurting with grace and truth.

- Would our church be a place where the hurting and lost are drawn to, and would you use us to open the eyes of their hearts?
 - Would our church grow because our body is sharing the Gospel and people are getting saved and then coming here to be discipled?
 - Would you give us an abundance of opportunities to share the Gospel with the lost?
 - Let Your glory fall like rain — bring revival that shakes hell's gates.
 - Lord, what else can I pray for our city that isn't on this list?

Week 4: God, Launch Us Into the Future (Oct 22–31)

Theme Verse: Ephesians 3:20 – “Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think...”

Songs to Listen to: “Holy Forever” by Chris Tomlin, “Made for More” by Josh Baldwin, “Good Plans” by Red Reds Worship, “You've Already Won” by Shane and Shane

Oct 22–31 (repeat daily):

- Pour out a vision — from Your mouth — that we will give our lives to for generations to come.
- Raise up future elders and leaders; let us have an overflow of qualified, Spirit-filled men and women in our church that are ready to lead.
- Explode our student, college, and children's ministries with salvations, baptisms, and leaders.
- Teach us to sustain this culture of prayer beyond October.
- Give wisdom about services, structure, and equipping so we look more like Jesus.
- Launch us into the next 25 years with vision, passion, and power.
- Fill every family and leader with joy, health, and authenticity.
- Make Fellowship a launching pad for missionaries, pastors, and Kingdom leaders.
- Would we be a place that encourages, equips and launches the next generation of leaders?
- Equip every member to live on mission daily — radical in serving, community, and evangelism.
- Keep our leaders humble, celebratory, and empowering of others.
- May this month of prayer be remembered for decades as the moment revival broke loose in our city.
- Lord, what else can I pray for our future that isn't on this list?
