Here is the info for Turkey Hunt on November 15.



Our goal is to bless the socks off the families that receive food boxes. There is a list at the bottom of this letter, and everything on that list will make up one full box.

We will be starting right at 6, so we ask that you arrive by 5:45. We will be explaining the rules of a scavenger hunt we will be going on. After the scavenger hunt, we will go to various stores around Searcy to buy food. You can support in one of 3 ways: 1. Send money with your student to purchase food or 2. Send the food listed with your student or 3. If you can't do either, please send your student anyways because it's going to be a FUN night. Your student's small group will be awarded points for how many boxes they can put together.

Parents, please know ***we will be leaving campus.*** Small group leaders will be the drivers.
